Dr. Rashid Hamed Al Balushi is an Associate Professor of Criminal Law at Sultan Qaboos University, Sultanate of Oman. He received a BA in law from the University of Alexandria in 1989, a Master of Forensic Sciences from the Police Academy 1999 and a PhD in Criminal Law from the University of Hull in the United Kingdom 2003. Dr. Rashid Al Balushi began his professional career as a Representative of the Public Prosecution in the Sultanate of Oman, and eventually became the Head of the Department of Legal Affairs and Professional Criminal Investigations, and later on, the Director of Information Management and Analysis of Criminal Investigations.
